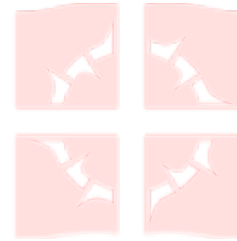


VBS Needs a Few Good Men

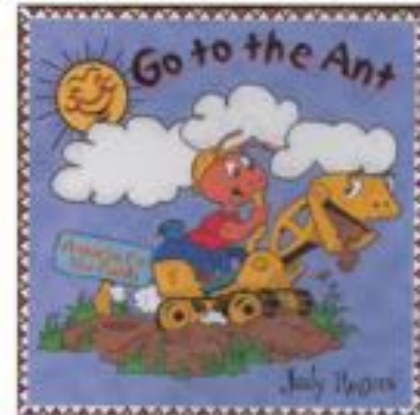

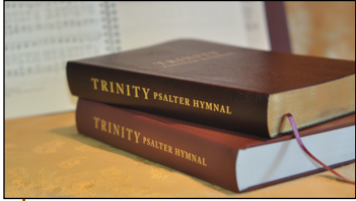

How did you come to know the Lord?

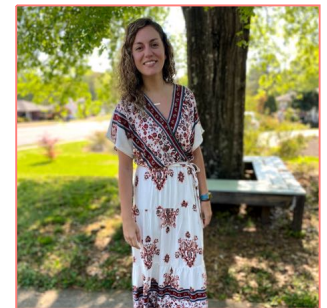

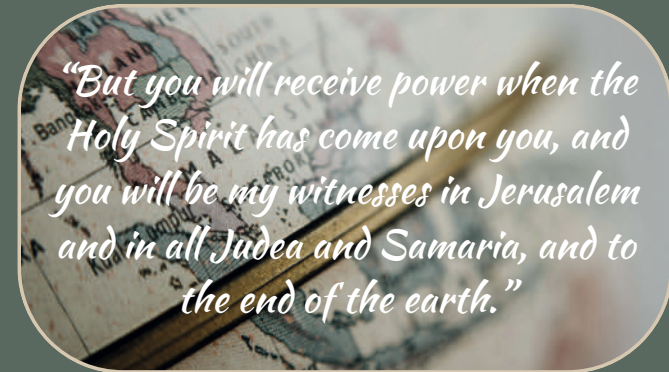
