4. That we live as stewards, not owners of God's possessions (Deut. 6:23; Ps. 24:1).

1. We must teach by the way we live (Deut. 6:1-2).

2. We must teach by what we say (Deut. 6:6-7; Eph. 4:29).

3. We teach by establishing and nurturing significant relationships (Deut. 6:7).
