Introduction:

We Must Request Godly Provisions Through Prayer (v.1-4)

1. Pray, "Help Lord."
2. 2 Tim. 3:1-5.
3. Pray against godlessness.

We Must Rely On God's Promises and Preservation (v.5-7)

1. Persecution is to be expected (2Tim.3:12).
2. God will keep the godly.
3. God's promises are sure (vs.6, cf. Titus 1:2; Heb.6:18).
4. 2 Peter 2:4-9.

We Must Rebuke Godless Principles and People (v.8).

1. The godly are grieved when wickedness abounds.
2. When sin is not rebuked and properly dealt with, it spreads.
3. Properly rebuking sin leads to exalting Jesus (cf. 2 Cor. 5:21).
