Psalm 51:1-19 Beyond Forgiveness — Motivation to Build a Kingdom David Rountree

- 1. Local churches generally do not survive past 100 years.
- 2. Psalm 51 concerns something beyond forgiveness motivation to build God's kingdom through making disciples (cf. 2 Cor.5:20; Acts 1:8; Matt.28:19).

The Matter Beyond Forgiveness

- 1. 2 Sam. 12:13, David's response to confrontation about his sin.
- 2. David's desire for more than forgiveness (vss.1, 2, 6, 10, 13, 15, 18).
- 3. God's concern is more than forgiveness (cf. Matt. 1:21; Luke 19:10).
- 4. Many times we wrongly substitute forgiveness and faithfulness for evangelism.

The Motivation Beyond Forgiveness

- 1. What doesn't motivate to forgiveness?
- 2. Not the condition of mankind in sin (vss.4,5).
- 3. Not the content of the gospel (vss.1-3).
- 4. Not the command to witness (vs.13).
- 5. The character of God in us (vs.17).

The Means To Getting Beyond Forgiveness

- 1. Seek a suffering God (vss.1-6,14). Consider the example of Paul (Phil.3:10).
- 2. Seek a sovereign God (vss.7-13). If God does not do his work within us there is no hope.
- 3. Seek a smiling God (vss.9, 11, 14-17).
- 4. Seek a saving God (vss. 13, 18-19).
