The Spirit's Ministry Planned Out (Joel 2:28-32)

- 1. The Days: "after this" (v. 28); "in those days" (v. 29); "last days" (Acts 2:17).
- 2. The Dissemination: "All flesh," "all mankind" (i.e. sons, daughters, old, young, male, and female: v.28-29). Num. 11:24-29.
- 3. The Deeds: "prophesy...dreams...visions" (v. 28). Num. 12:6.
- 4. The Demonstration: "wonders in the sky" (v. 30-31).
- 5. The Deliverance: "whoever calls on the name of the Lord will be delivered" (v. 32).

The Spirit's Ministry Poured Out (Acts 2:1-39)

- 1. The Tongues of the Spirit (v. 1-13).
- 2. The Teaching of the Spirit (v. 14-21).
- 3. The Testimony of the Spirit (v. 22-36). The Spirit's focus is on Christ (John 15:26).
- 4. The Transmission of the Spirit (v. 37-39).

Two Primary Applications

- 1. We must be filled with the spirit (regenerated by the Spirit) to be saved (Titus 3:5; John 3:3, 5; Ezek. 36:26, 27). All flesh can be saved. God's salvation is extended to every nation or ethnic group, male and female.
- 2. We must be filled with the spirit (empowered by the Spirit) to proclaim Christ or witness effectively for Christ (Acts 1:8). When we pray for more of the Spirit it is not for our own personal benefit, it is for the good of other Christians (1 Cor. 12:7) and for the salvation of the lost.
