The Law Moves from Tablets to Hearts (Jer.31:31-34)

- 1. The law is fulfilled (v.32).
- 2. The Law is on hearts (v.33).
- 3. NC members know the Lord (v.34a).
- 4. NC members' sins are forgiven permanently (v.34).

The Law Moves from National Church to International Church

Civil, Ceremonial, Moral laws
Jer. 34:13-14
Ezek. 44:6-8
Col. 2:14-17; Heb. 8:11-15
1Pet.2:13-15

The Law Moves as a Moral Unit—the Ten Commandments

- 1. Jer. 31:33
- 2. Eph.6:2-3
- 3. 1Tim.1:6-11
 - a) The law is intrinsically good
 - b) The law is still very much needed
 - c) The law in 1Tim1:6-11 is expressly the Ten Commandments

Why does all of this matter?

- $\cdot\,$ We need to with God, his law is perfect and good (Ps.19:7-11).
- \cdot We need to use his law daily (Ps.119:9-11; 119:105).
- $\cdot\,$ We need God's law for loving our Redeemer and others.

The Ten Commandment—Short Summary

- 1. Have no other gods
- 2. Make no idols
- 3. Speak well of God and for God
- 4. Keep the Sabbath Day special
- 5. Honor father and mother
- 6. Commit no murder
- 7. Commit no adultery
- 8. Commit no stealing
- 9. Tell no Lies against our neighbor, and
- 10. Do not covet Love the Lord our God with all our heart, mind, soul and strength and our neighbor as ourselves.
