Sins Unto Death

OUR MINISTRY AWARENESS

OUR MINISTRY AWFULNESS—SINS UNTO DEATH WILL NOT BE FIXED

Various Interpretations:

- a. Blasphemy against HS (Mk.3:20-30)
- b. Distinction between capital offenses and non-capital offenses
- c. Apostasy by a Christian

Sins unto Death:

- a. Grumbling and complaining against God
- b. Wrongly taking the Lord's Supper (1Cor.11:28-32)
- c. Sins that bother the conscience in James 5:14-15

OUR MINISTRY ACTION

- 1. Reconciliation: It is the will of God for us to care for our Christian brother's welfare. (Gal.6:1-2)
- 2. Repent: Recognize it is the plan of God that we deal immediately with sin and not trifle with it. (1Jn.1:9; Ro.6:23)
- 3. Request grace: Let every sight of sinning be stimulus for our praying.
- 4. Rest in Christ: It is clearly God's will that his children not rest in sin.
