## OUR MINISTRY AWARENESS

### OUR MINISTRY AWFULNESS—SINS UNTO DEATH WILL NOT BE FIXED

Various Interpretations:

- Blasphemy against HS (Mk.3:20-30)
- Distinction between capital offenses and non-capital offenses
- Apostasy by a Christian

Sins unto Death:

- Grumbling and complaining against God
- Wrongly taking the Lord’s Supper (1Cor.11:28-32)
- Sins that bother the conscience in James 5:14-15

## OUR MINISTRY ACTION

- Reconciliation: It is the will of God for us to care for our Christian brother’s welfare. (Gal.6:1-2)
- Repent: Recognize it is the plan of God that we deal immediately with sin and not trifle with it. (1Jn.1:9; Ro.6:23)
- Request grace: Let every sight of sinning be stimulus for our praying.
- Rest in Christ: It is clearly God’s will that his children not rest in sin.
