WHY WE SING IT

Where do we go when we are needy, weak, and afraid? To whom can we turn when we are disappointed, finding ourselves unsatisfied with what the world offers? Is there anyone or anything that is constant when we and our world are ever-changing?

Far from being a simple "Sunday School answer", we turn to Jesus! He invites us to come to him and drink of living water that never runs dry (John 4:14), to run to him in our weakness for there his power is on display in abundant grace (2 Cor. 12:9), and to receive his peace that settles our hearts and calms our fears (John 14:27).
