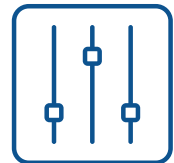

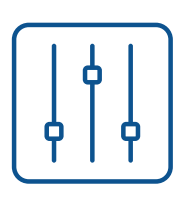

The Why

The How

1. Structure

- Worship (One-team) = Music & Tech (Two sub-teams)

2. Worship Vision Night

- Yearly rhythm of envisioning, on/off ramp for serving, a time to express feedback.

5. Multi-generational Worship Serving Pipeline

- Pray for a multi-generational worship ministry.

6. Preparation

- Jonathan recommitting to have services and resources planned *at least* a week in advance of the mid-week rehearsal.
- Join me in preparing ahead of time *before* coming to mid-week rehearsal.

7. Punctuality

- While life happens and sometimes throws our schedules out of balance, let us pursue punctuality as best we can to respect one another and serve with excellence.
- Mid-week rehearsal schedule
 - i. 7:00 - 7:30 - Vocals Only
 - ii. 7:30 - 7:45 - Prayer
 - iii. 7:45 - 9:00 - Full Rehearsal
- Sunday morning please be ready to start at 8am so we can run through the whole service and have plenty of time to break before the service, pray, and greet people.
