OUR REPUTATION IN CHRIST (v. 1)

- 1. The seven spirits (3:1) are the same as in 1:4 and 4:5 and in 5:6. The seven stars were mentioned in 1:20 as messengers to the churches.
- 2. The Sardis Church has a good name but yet they were dead (v.1). How can this be? What are some examples near us?
- 3. Some churches may be described as "holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power" (2 Tim. 3:5); as having faith without works (James 2:17, 26); as having a good appearance (Ezek. 33:30-32) without conformity to God's Word.
- 4. Jesus says "I know your deeds." What kind of church is a "dead deeds church" in our day?

 - 6) and bring forth the fruit of it in their lives. (Luke8:15; James1:25)
