## The Ten Commandments

Exodus 20:1-17

1. Have no other gods
2. Make no idols
3. Speak well of God and for God
4. Keep the Sabbath Day special
5. Honor father and mother
6. Commit no murder
7. Commit no adultery
8. Commit no stealing
9. Tell no lies against our neighbor
10. Do not covet
